

600 yard Mid-Range Prone Rifle Clinic

I will be holding a prone shooting clinic at the 600 yard range on May 28th in Keene. New shooters are the focus of this event, but is open to anyone wanting to brush up on the basics.

We will meet at the club house at 9:00 am to sign up and collect a modest fee (\$10.00) to cover range costs. Basic equipment requirements, safety and range procedures, and basic shooting techniques will be discussed before we move to the firing line.

On the firing line, we will demonstrate what we discussed including shooting positions and SAFETY. We will then divide into two groups. One group will shoot and the other will operate the targets in the butts. After about an hour, the groups will switch. Everyone will get equal time shooting and pulling targets. With time permitting we may get to shoot twice.

I like to have all participants meet back in the club house after the event for questions and feedback about the clinic.

I have two loaner rifles for those without equipment and will supply ammo for \$10.00 per box of 20 rounds. For those who want to use their own rifle, Ron Avery and I will be available on Saturday April 20th at 10:00 am at the 200 yard line (weather permitting) to get you sighted in for the 600 yard line. If you are shooting 5.56mm/.223 rem. the minimum bullet weight is 69 grains. (55 and 62 grain bullets are not allowed for the 600 yard range.)
