
I am approaching the end of my first quarter in the job and am still, clearly, rattling around in Larry's shoes. Those are big shoes to fill...

We had excellent Team scores again in 2018 and expect our 3-Position Team of Ashley, Kyle, Natalie, and Evie will be ranked

in the top 5 in the Nation. In 4–Position, we had the exact same score as last year, so should hold our ranking as 7th. We expect 2018 results to be available in June.

Scholastic All American List. Major. Greg Ganio is in his



Action Pistol events will be held on different weekends this season, and there will be some special events throughout the summer for those interested in giving action shooting a try.

Our regular (IDPA-like) matches will be held the third Saturday of the month this year instead of the traditional second Saturday. The dates are April 21, May 19, June 16, July 21 (during "Family Day"), and Aug. 18. There is a conflict in September for the third Saturday. We will hold our match on September 8th.

The weekend change was made to adapt to Pioneer Sportsmen's now scheduling IDPA matches on the second Saturday of the month. Our switch will allow for CCSSEF members to more easily participate in events at both clubs, and hopefully add to the number of competitors at these matches.

Also new this year, Action Pistol will offer opportunities for interested members to try out Steel Challenge-type shooting. A single, steel stage will be set up during various events throughout the summer. You'll be able to stop by with a handgun (no magnums or 10mm!), .22lr rifle or pistol caliber carbine and run through the stage. Watch the website and the next newsletter for more information.

Wednesday night practices will start very soon. Check the website for an official starting date and more info. The practices begin at 4:00 p.m., but even if you can't show up until 6:30 or later you can still get in about an hour or more of shooting. The cost is \$3.00 for members and \$5.00 for non-members. Instruction is provided at no additional charge.

The Wednesday night practices are a great way to learn and develop competition-type shooting skills which can help you defend

yourself and protect others. You'll get to shoot in a variety of situations under the close



supervision of range safety officers. Action Pistol stresses weapon familiarity, target identification ("threats" vs. "non-threats"), rapid engagement of targets, accurate fire, quick reloads, and safe movement with a firearm.

High Power Rifle Schedule Posted

Hope everyone has survived the winter ok, and I know you're anxious to get out on the range.

Like last year, the High Power committee has planned an ambitious season. We start with two warm up off hand fun matches at 200 yards, followed by the first of six New Hampshire High Power League matches.

We will host four 600 yard NRA approved prone mid-range matches and the NH State Mid-Range State Championship. Two M-1 Garand matches and a vintage sniper/service rifle match are scheduled. A 50 round and an 80 round National Match Course along with an Excellence In Competition "Rifle Leg Match" will be shot here.

Two Service Rifle clinics and a 600 yard wind read-

ing/prone shooting technique clinic will be held. The 600 yard morning and afternoon prone practices start in May.

Like last year, I plan on being available most Saturday mornings from 10:00 am till noon to get you sighted in to shoot at the 600 yard range. Several members qualified last summer and are having a blast at the Thursday practices. A few have tried their luck at the matches and have done remarkably well. If you shoot two NRA approved matches (120 rounds for record), you will receive a Mid-Range Classification Card which allows you to compete at your skill level.

We will also be hosting this year's "Mini-Palma" match. This is a one long range/mid-range match between teams from New England and the Canadian Maritime Provinces. This

will be the 41st year of the competition and the first time it will shot on our range. This is my fourth year as the US team captain and several shooters from our club have been on the team.

The dates for all of the high power rifle events are also posted on the main calendar and listed on the High Power web page. Check out these matches. There is something for everyone. Contact the event organizers for details.


