## 600 YARD RIFLE PRACTICE Thursday starting:

## April 30, 2020 through October

## 9:00 AM until Noon & 4:00PM until dusk

20 shooter limit per session \$5.00 fee to cover costs - \$10.00 on E-Targets when available. Open to members and non-members - must have 600 yard "zeros" and safe ammo - no tracers - 5.56/223 must use 69 grain or heavier bullets

Arrive by 8:45 am or 3:45pm. Shooters are divided into two groups. One group shoots first and the other group goes to the "pit" and sets up targets, puts up wind flags, and pulls targets for the first shooting group. Shooters have a block time limit of 45 minuets to shoot unlimited rounds. The groups then switch. The group in the "pits" last will put targets away and take down flags. E-Targets will eliminate pit changes and permit more shooting.

Always check the calendar on the website (www.ccssef.org) to make sure the range is open and practice is on. With all of the work being done to the ranges and law enforcement training taking place there may a Thursday impacted and practice may be canceled.

\*\*\*Those without 600 yard zeros can get qualified to shoot the 600 yard practices on Saturdays at the 200 yard rifle range from 10:00 AM until noon - weather permitting. Most center fire high power rifle cartridges will work. Cartridges like 22 Hornet 25-20 etc are NOT SUFFICIENT but .223, .243, .308 etc. are fine. Iron sights that are adjustable like military or target sights or scopes are needed.
