My name is Dan Cormier and I'm interested in serving on the board of directors for the Cheshire County Shooting Sports Education Foundation. As a board member, I would like to increase the number of shooting activities held at the range to generate interest in the sport and enhance firearms safety and education. My plan is to promote the foundation locally to
