Previously, Keith was the host of the "First Look" morning drive radio program, which aired from 6:00 am to 9:00 am weekdays on New Hampshire's WNTK and WUVR, and the regional New England "Daily Review" program airing from 2:00 pm until 4:00 on Nashua's WSMN.

Keith is the past President and Vice President of Oath Keeper's Florida state chapter, and also served as the co-director of training for Florida Carry, the sunshine state's sole gun rights lobbying organization. He previously served as the Chairman of the Sullivan County, NH Republican Committee, and was a candidate for Republican Party Chairman of the New Hampshire GOP.
