









CCSSEF Foundation Ferry Brook Jr. Shooters Rifle Team

We've been having New Member SIGN-UPs for our 2021-2022 season since Saturday September 11th. We're up to 18 new participants. With 10 returning shooters, our roster is at 28 active athletes. In addition to our Saturday sessions, our weekly practices on Wednesday evenings from 4-8pm at the Ct River Sportsmen's Club Air Gun Range have resumed for our Gold & Silver (travel) Team.

We're still waiting on the final results of our September 19th PLYMOUTH INTERNATIONAL PRONE POSTAL MATCH. There were a total of 24 representatives for the New Hampshire 'Plymouth'. The folks in the UK also fired their targets on the 19th.

Work still continues on our new Indoor Range. There is steady progress, but still lots to do. Target carriers and firing point booths were installed the week of Nov 15th.

Preliminary results for the three 2021 Junior Sectional Matches we competed in are out. We held the NH Junior Invitational Match at the Peterborough Sportsmen's Indoor Range on Saturday November 20th. There were 13 Competitors invited. Seven from our Team and 6 from the Hudson F&G Junior Team. Ashlee Peters from the Hudson Team took Gold Medal. Our Team Members Anna Bittner won the Silver, Shea Wilkins-Fleck 3rd Place Bronze and Mason May earning the 4th place Bronze. Anna was the winner of the coveted 'Dog Tag' Award in the Air Rifle Shoot Off.

We have applied for two NRA Junior Sectional Matches in 2022. A 4-Position Smallbore in February and a 3-Position Air Rifle Match in March. We will also be holding the CMP 3 Position Air Rifle NH State Championship in January and our Juniors will also participate in the annual CMP 3P Air Rifle Postal Match. Our annual Indoor Prone Match held in December may be put on later this winter if we have time. Our Gold & Silver Team has other CMP Matches, USA Shooting Junior Olympic Tryouts and NRA Junior Sectional Matches to attend this winter. A very busy schedule!

Once our Indoor range is established, we will publish the list of our supporters. There have been many Junior Team Members, Alumni and Friends that are donors for the Indoor Range Project. 
